





- **❖** Homily then **Creed**:

All: I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made.

For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man.

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets.

I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church.

I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

#### WORD of God – are we Listening better?

→ Use these notes to pray through Lectio Divina on the text of this Sunday's Gospel:

**Lectio**: Readings in Lent are chosen to lead us on a journey to renew our commitment to our faith at Easter. So, our Gospel text is 13 chapters on from last Sunday's text. Last Sunday the devil was probing Jesus with his temptations, beginning with: "If you are the Son of God. The disciples and those with Jesus were being led through Jesus' words, actions and miracles (13 chapters) to believe in him as the Son of God. Peter, James and John had been with Jesus from the start of his ministry and would be there at his death. The transfiguration reveals to them the truth that Jesus is the Son of God.

Read: **Matthew 17: 1 - 9** 

**Meditatio:** How am I going on my journey of Lent? Who is Jesus for me? Who are the key people who have been with me in my life? What glimpses of God's glory have I seen? [Tents, for the Jews, were associated with the presence of God among them. Creation was God's tent over them (like a cloud), the Ark was kept in a Tent and then in the Temple, they celebrated the 'Feast of Tents' (Tabernacles).] Where is God present in my life, my tents?

**Oratio:** Pray that we will recognize Jesus' presence with us; he is God's Son. Pray for a renewal of faith through Lent. Pray that God will spread his tent over us and bless us.

Contemplatio - Dwell in stillness, simply aware of the boundless expanse of mercy that surrounds you.

After your prayer - Make the responses at Mass not just routine but rather, expressions of your faith in Jesus' presence among us.
