#### WORD of God - are we Listening better ?

→Use these notes to pray through <u>Lectio Divina</u> on the text of this Sunday's Gospel:

**Lectio**: Our text is in two parts. The first part comes after the wise men had left (the Epiphany, next week). The second part comes after the slaying of the innocents by king Herod and, some time after that, the death of Herod. It is through dreams that Joseph takes his family into exile and safety in Egypt and also, in a dream, that Joseph returns his family to safety in Israel. Joseph and Mary are caring for the Infant Jesus through tough times of exile and then of homecoming.

#### Read Matthew 2: 13 - 15, 19 - 23

**Meditatio:** How does the Lord speak to me? Is it through dreams? Have there been quiet times when I have heard the Lord? When have I felt in danger or insecure? Can I identify with the plight of exiles or refugees? Is *coming home* a good feeling for me? How important is security for me; e.g. *being settled*?

**Oratio:** Pray to be better at listening to the Lord when he speaks to you. Pray that we will make quiet and reflective times so the Lord can speak to us. Pray for families who *fear for their lives*. Pray for families who must leave their homes seeking refuge and safety. Pray for innocent victims of oppression. Pray that refugees may be treated with respect and compassion. Pray for peace, harmony and security in families.

**Contemplatio** – Dwell in stillness, simply aware of the boundless expanse of mercy that surrounds you.

After your prayer – Use the holidays as a gift for family time. *ZFr Joe*
