All peoples, clap your hands, cry to God with shouts of joy! For the Lord, the Most High, we must fear, great king over all the earth.

> GOSPEL: Matthew 28:16-20

WORD of God – are we Listening better ? → Use these notes to pray through Lectio Divina on the text of this Sunday's Gospel:

Lectio: Our Gospel this Sunday is the last verses of Matthew's Gospel. Jesus has died on the Cross and been buried. Three days later the women find the empty tomb. A angel had then appeared telling them to not be afraid but to go and tell the disciples that must go to Galilee to a mountain where the will see the risen Lord. Then the incident of the guards being bribed to say that the disciples had stolen the body of Jesus is told. Then our text follows where the disciples are on the way to Galilee. The disciples must have been confused, not understanding what was taking place – why Galilee?, which mountain?. had Jesus not died?. But they would remember what Jesus said. Jesus then ascends to heaven though Matthew does not mention it but it is recalled in the first verses of the Asts of the Apostles 1:1-11 (1st Reading).

Read: 28 : 16 – 20

The eleven disciples set out for Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had arranged to meet them. When they saw him they fell down before him, though some hesitated. Jesus came up and spoke to them. He said, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, make disciples of all the nations; baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teach them to observe all the commands I gave you. And know that I am with you always; yes, to the end of time.'

Meditatio: Am I confused about the Resurrection or where Jesus is now? Where can I go to meet Jesus? Have I experienced the presence of God on a mountain, on Arthur's Seat? Have I ever 'fallen down', kissed the ground etc to express joy and/or relief – on getting out of my sickbed, on finishing a sea voyage, on coming to a new home or country, on getting outside after being (isolated) at home etc etc? How am I responding to the Lord's commission to 'Go and make disciples'? Can I remember the joy of presenting a child for Baptism and/or being present at a Baptism? Do I remember my Baptism when I make the Sign of the Cross? Am I observing the commands of Jesus in my life? How have I experienced that Jesus is with me? Can I remember tough times when the Lord was with me, though, at the time, I didn't realize it?

Oratio: Pray for faith in, and understanding of, the Resurrection. Pray for those who have been misled about the truth of the Resurrection. Pray for those who hesitate about their faith i.e. have a fragile faith. Pray the Good News may be told in all nations. Pray for parents, that they will prouldly present their children for Baptism. Pray that we will all live up to our Baptismal responsibilities. Pray that all may experience the joy at experiencing the closeness of God. Pray that the world will be renewed as the Lord brings us through this Pandemic.

Contemplatio – Dwell in stillness, simply aware of the boundless expanse of mercy that surrounds you.

After your prayer – Make the Sign of the Cross and remember Jesus is with us till the end of time.

THE ANNUNCIATION




THE CORONATION
