WORD of God - are we Listening better?

→Use these notes to pray through <u>Lectio Divina</u> on the text of this Sunday's Gospel:

Lectio: Jesus has grown up with his family in Nazareth in Galilee. However, no details of his growing to adulthood are given in Matthew's Gospel. It is time to live out his role as Messiah and Saviour. So John the Baptist is presented as the one who is preparing for the coming Messiah but he is not the Messiah. When Jesus comes to John for baptism, John has a problem. In baptizing Jesus, he might be seen to be greater than Jesus. But Jesus' baptism was God's way of inaugurating the way followers of Jesus would share in the life of the Spirit – our baptisms.

Read Matthew 3: 13 - 17

Meditatio: How has my growing up prepared me for my vocation, i.e. my calling from God? What memories or records do I have of my Baptism? What does my Baptism mean to me? Do I do the right thing not worrying what people might say or think? How have I experienced the Holy Spirit in my life? How does God the Father care for me, i.e. show me his favour?

Oratio: Pray that the Sacrament of Baptism will enable us to continue following Jesus. Pray that parents will seek Baptism for their children. Pray that parents will be agents of God the Father's care. May parents provide an environment in which the seeds of faith, sown in their children at Baptism, will come to maturity. Pray that we will be faithful to our Baptismal vows.

Contemplatio – Dwell in stillness, simply aware of the boundless expanse of mercy that surrounds you.

After your prayer – Remember the gift of Baptism thatyou rely on as you dip into the Holy Water on enteringand leaving the church.\$\mathcal{E}\$ Fr Joe
