

***** Homily then **Creed**:

All: I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made.

For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man.

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets.

I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church.

I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

At the end of the preparation of the gifts:

WORD of God – are we Listening better ? →Use these notes to pray through Lectio Divina on the text of this Sunday's Gospel:

Lectio: Our text is from the start of Matthew's Gospel. He has just related the genealogy of Jesus Christ from Abraham through King David to Jacob the father of Joseph betrothed (engaged) to Mary. Joseph probably knew that Mary was with child through the Holy Spirit but did not know what his role should be. If he took Mary to his home he would be taking on the role of the child's father and so give the child his name. The Lord, through a dream, clarifies Joseph's role.

Read Matthew 1: 18 - 24

Meditatio: Am I clear about Joseph's role in Jesus' birth? Do I truly believe that Mary conceived Jesus through the Holy Spirit? Am I unsure about what God is doing in my life? Has God helped me understand my life through, meditation, reflecting or dreams? How clear is my vocation to me i.e. what God is calling me to do in my life? Am I living out my vocation?

Oratio: Pray that people may see clearly that God has come among us in Christ born of Mary through the Holy Spirit. Pray for fathers that they may be clear about their role in their families. Pray that God may make clear his will for us. Pray for family harmony at Christmas time. Pray for parents, that they may form (name) their children in life giving ways.

Contemplatio – Dwell in stillness, simply aware of the boundless expanse of mercy that surrounds you.

After your prayer – At meals remember to thank God for all his gifts especially for the gift of Christ our Saviour. $\mathscr{L}Fr$ Joe
