WORD of God – are we Listening better ?

→Use these notes to pray through <u>Lectio Divina</u> on the text of this Sunday's Gospel:

Lectio: Jesus is concluding his time of explanations that, that, if the people were listening, would help them to understand his self-emptying Passion and Death which will soon be enacted before them. He has just pointed out the widow who put into the treasury ALL she had to live on (*The Widow's Mite* Lk 21:1-4). So, how would they live on after his Death? Jesus gives some warnings and explanations.

Read Luke 21: 5 – 19

Meditatio: Do I understand the meaning of Jesus' Passion and Death? What is my world built on – possessions, wealth and property? Am I ready to give ALL for Jesus? Or, am I waiting for someone to tell me 'the time is near'? Am I strong enough to face being persecuted for my faith? Am I going to endure to the end? What do I think of people who make predictions about the end of the world? Natural disasters – how do I understand them?

Oratio: Pray for wisdom to understand the meaning of Jesus' death and resurrection. Pray that Jesus and the coming of his kingdom may be the basis of our lives. Pray in thanks for the heritage we have custody of in our churches and their adornments. Pray not to be deceived by end time predictions. Pray for courage to stand firm through trials of life and natural disasters. Pray for deeper faith to come through persecutions.

Contemplatio – Dwell in stillness, simply aware of the boundless expanse of mercy that surrounds you.

After your prayer – Pray with conviction the prayer after the Lord's Prayer: "For the kingdom ..." ZFr Joe
