

For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

❖ Homily then **Creed**:

All: I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, he was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen

❖ At the end of the preparation of the gifts: Fr Joe: Pray my brothers and sisters that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father. (ALL STAND) now:

WORD of God - are we Listening better?

→ Use these notes to pray through <u>Lectio Divina</u> on the text of this Sunday's Gospel:

Lectio: Only Matthew's Gospel relates the visit to Bethlehem of some wise men from the East. He omits details of the stable & the manger, shepherds and angels. Matthew rather relates Jesus' birth in (the town of David) Bethlehem connecting Jesus to the line of David through which the Messiah was to come. Matthew also teaches through this visit, about: a journey to Christ of not just the Chosen People but of all people (the Gentiles), a foreshadowing of Christ's rejection and finally a reference (in the Gifts) to Jesus': royalty, adoration as God and burial.

Read Matthew 2: 1 - 12

Meditatio: How is my journey to Christ going? What star do I follow; i.e. how is God leading me? How far have I come on my journey? Am I set in my ways or ready to go wherever God leads? Have I ever lost sight of Christ? Have I hidden my true intentions by lying? Is what I say, what I do? Have I experienced joy when my prayers have been answered or when, with faith, I have come through dark times? How do I give homage to God? What gifts do I have to offer God in homage?

Oratio: Pray that Christ will be the light, the star, that leads us. Pray for true wisdom. Pray for those who reject Christ. Pray for those in authority, rulers and leaders. Pray for those who scheme to bring down good people. Pray for joy at the birth of Christ our Saviour/Messiah. Pray for generosity in giving.

Contemplatio – Dwell in stillness, simply aware of the boundless expanse of mercy that surrounds you.

After your prayer – Continue, in faith, on your journey to Christ.
