
► COVID-19 Pandemic:

WORD of God – are we Listening better ?

→ **Use these notes** to pray through **Lectio Divina** on the text of this Sunday's Gospel:

Lectio: This weekend we are celebrating a fundamental belief as Christians in **the Trinity, one God three persons**. In our text, Nicodemus, a Jewish official yet a seeker of the truth, wants to know who Jesus really is. Jesus can only be understood in his relationship to the Father and the Holy Spirit, i.e. the Trinity, the ONE God. This understanding is only in seed in the Gospels and would only be fully developed as the early Church lived out their faith in Jesus and the Holy Spirit led the Church to the fullness of truth. The Mystery of the Trinity brings together the Jewish belief in **one God** and the revelation in Jesus and through the Holy Spirit, that **God is Love**. This Love (i.e. God) is expressed in the interrelationship of three equal persons. Love always involves **three** realities, the ¹lover, the ²loved and the ³bond which unites them.

Next weekend we will celebrate another of our fundamental beliefs – the reality of God's presence with us in the Eucharist. Love always reaches out to others.

Read: **John 3: 16 – 18**

Jesus said to Nicodemus, 'God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not be lost but may have eternal life.

For God sent his Son into the world not to condemn the world, but so that through him the world might be saved.

No one who believes in him will be condemned; but whoever refuses to believe is condemned already, because he has refused to believe in the name of God's only Son.'

Meditatio: Am I a seeker of the truth? Do I know who Jesus is? Who is Jesus for me? Does my belief in Jesus shape my life? Do I trust that Jesus is offering me THE way to eternal life? Am I afraid of being 'lost'? do I appreciate who much God loves me? Am I worthy that God sent his Son to save ME ? do I pray for the salvation of the world? Do I experience the Holy Spirit within me enabling me to take the path of love

as Jesus has shown me, i.e. to commendation by the Father and not condemnation by my sinning? How do I experience God – as Father, as Jesus (Son) and as the Holy Spirit?

Oratio: Pray an understanding of who Jesus is. Pray for all who are seekers of God, of the Truth. Pray that truth may not be obscured by misinformation. Pray for courage to face the truth in our lives. Pray to God the Father that everyone may know his personal care for them. Pray to Jesus the Son of God that his way of love may be lived throughout the world. Pray to the Holy Spirit that through his gifts to us we may be part of the renewal of our world. Pray that the Mystery of the Trinity may not confuse people but lead them to understand the ways of love. Pray for unity in our world.

Contemplatio – Dwell in stillness, simply aware of the boundless expanse of mercy that surrounds you.

After your prayer – Begin and end your prayer with the Sign of the Cross.



We beseech Thee, hear us.


That we may finally enjoy the sight of Thee in glory,
