

WORD of God – are we Listening better?

→ Use these notes to pray through <u>Lectio Divina</u> on the text of this Sunday's Gospel:

Lectio: Our Gospel this Sunday is set in the long discourse of Jesus with his apostles at the Last Supper. The apostles will only understand what happened that night, some 50 days later, when the Holy Spirit comes upon them at Pentecost. That night they shared in the first Eucharist; Judas went to betray Jesus; when Jesus had said that he would not be with them much longer and that they should love one another just as he loves them, it provokes Peter to ask where Jesus was going and why he can't follow; Jesus predicted Peter's triple betrayal. For us, Jesus has risen the Holy Spirit empowers us to live the command of love. Yet do we understand where Jesus is present for us now? Will we believe in Jesus and not betray him?

Read: John 14: 1 - 12

Jesus said to his disciples: 'Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God still, and trust in me. There are many rooms in my Father's house; if there were not, I should have told you. I am going now to prepare a place for you, and after I have gone and prepared you a place, I shall return to take you with me; so that where I am you may be too. You know the way to the place where I am going.'

Thomas said, 'Lord, we do not know where you are going, so how can we know the way?' Jesus said: 'I am the Way, the Truth and the Life. No one can come to the Father except through me. If you know me, you know my Father too. From this moment you know him and have seen him.'

Philip said, 'Lord, let us see the Father and then we shall be satisfied.'

'Have I been with you all this time, Philip,' said Jesus to him 'and you still do not know me. To have seen me is to have seen the Father, so how can you say, "Let us see the Father?' Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words I say to you I do not speak as from myself: it is the Father, living in me, who is doing this work. You must believe me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; believe it on the evidence of this work, if for no other reason.

I tell you most solemnly, whoever believes in me will perform the same works as I do myself, he will perform even greater works, because I am going to the Father.' Meditatio: Am I troubled at the moment; am I still trusting in God? How much do I long to gather together in our church for Masses and the Sacraments? Do I feel how Jesus is with me where I am — in my home? Am I concerned about the way I am living my faith at the moment? Do look towards even better ways to live my faith in the future — when this pandemic is over? Though the future way of life is unknown, is my relationship with Jesus still strong because He is the Way the Truth and the Life? When faced with such an uncertain future, do I need Jesus to give me signs before I believe in him? Jesus has completed his work as Saviour on Earth, am I open to the workings of the Holy Spirit to perform the same and even greater works than Jesus?

Oratio: Pray that our churches will again be opened and able to be used in the fullest ways. Pray that our churches will not fall into disrepair. Pray for a renewed presence of Jesus in the rooms of our homes. Pray that our way of life in the future will help us be even better disciples of Jesus. Pray that all people will have the help they need to keep healthy in mind and body? Pray for our Bishops who are meeting this week. Pray for mothers, may their service always be appreciated. Pray for all who are responsible for shaping our way of life, now and into the future.

Contemplatio – Dwell in stillness, simply aware of the boundless expanse of mercy that surrounds you.

After your prayer — Sit in a quiet place and let the Lord be with you.
